The format of abstract: text in MS Word with Times New Roman and 1.5 spacing, Title: all capital, bold, 14pt, Author (s): bold, 12 pt, Address: (11pt) e-mail: only one email of Corresponding author should be provided, Abstract body: (12pt). Complete sentences, active verbs, and the third person should be used, and the abstract should be written in the past tense. Keywords: up to 6 to 8 (12pt).
